B. Public Relations Efforts for Events

- The committee needs help in enlisting ushers and persons for other light duties to support the various activities planned for October and November. Any committee member, employee, or student group who can help should let **E. Gaskill** know as soon as possible. Those present at the meeting volunteered where they could arrange their schedule.
- **S. Lenig, E. Gaskill, M. Darrell, and G. Hudson** agreed to prepare public relations notices for various upcoming events.
- **S. Lenig** and **E. Gaskill** are still planning on contacting various college groups and their advisors to support events.

- **E. Gaskill** will contact **H. Cobb** in an effort to have art students look at the Lyceum web page and offer constructive improvements and additions. All other members should provide comments directly to the Chair.

C. Lyceum Calendar and Events Schedule

- **E. Gaskill** issued an updated events schedule for evaluation and discussion. The months were covered again, and October and November have basically been finalized. She emphasized the importance of getting all planned events on the calendar due to the large number of events and possible competing resources needed for the events.
- **S. Lenig's** drama students are evaluating what they may want to do in the remaining time of fall semester.

- **G. Hudson** proposed that Leslie Satcher, a professional songwriter/singer in Nashville, be offered a performance for lecture and demonstration along with a small concert in the late January-early February timeframe. The Committee agreed so that action could proceed. He is to work with **Kathy Hudnall** and **A. Reeves** on this event.
- **Mark Cabus**, a one-man show for Christmas, has been finalized so that this event will occur.

D. Status of Budget, Grants, and Other Funding Possibilities

- **A. Scott** indicated that seven (7) contracts were in various stages of the approval process. The Committee extends sincere thanks to her for the hard work and dedication exerted for pushing these contracts through. Without her work, the events would not be on schedule.

E. Black History Month

- The Committee is seeking additional ideas for other events during this month. Any suggestions are welcome.

- **S. Lenig** proposed that about \$1,000 of the budget be set aside just for the events that may be developed for this month. The Committee was in agreement.
- **Anne Reeves** suggested that the Wooten Bros. (jazz, R/B type act) might be a possibility during that timeframe.
- **E. Gaskill** will talk further with **Christa Martin** and **Cecilia Johnson** regarding the events.
