This would keep track of which students attend Columbia State events as well as how many attend the events. Dawn will continue to update Lyceum on this matter. Dawn is also interested in doing her part to support Lyceum events.

3. Beth Duffield, Director of Development and Alumni Relations, introduced herself to the group and stated that her office is interested in collaborating with Lyceum to bring events to Columbia State campuses. Beth will work with Lyceum in the future and will be present at Lyceum meetings when feasible.

4. Stuart Lenig encouraged Lyceum to support and help promote the Humanities Series lectures upcoming. He also encouraged Lyceum members to help support and participate in a possible concert at Columbia State to raise money for the victims of the recent earthquake/tsunami disaster in Japan. 5. Emily Gaskill reported on the Lyceum budget. According to Elaine Curtis, we are managing Lyceum events within the budget. Remaining events require \$770.00 (excluding printing and photocopying costs).
