APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

First-Time College Student

(No prior college attendance)

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Submit official* high school transcripts or GED
- Submit official* ACT/SAT scores if taken (not required if 21 years of age or older)
- *Students will be placed in Developmental courses based on sub-scores of 18 or below on the math, English or reading sections of the ACT or below 450 on the critical writing or math portions of the SAT. If no ACT or SAT scores are available, placement testing will be required.*
- Submit immunization information

Readmission

(Previously attended Columbia State)

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Applicants that have attended other institutions since attending Columbia State must have official* transcripts sent from **each** institution
- *If it has been five or more years since you last attended Columbia State, please resubmit all transcripts.*

Transfer

(Previously attended another college)

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Submit official* transcripts from **each** high school, college, business or technical school attended
- *Transfer students without previous math or English coursework will be required to take a placement test prior to registration. Students that took the Compass placement test at another Tennessee Board of Regents Institution within the last three years **should have the scores sent to the Office of Admissions.***
- Submit immunization information

**Official transcripts are those received from the issuing institution by mail, fax, or in person in a sealed envelope*

New applicants are required to submit a \$10 non-refundable, one-time application fee payment with this application

Special Undergraduate *(Not pursuing a degree, but taking college level courses)*

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Submit official* transcripts from the last institution attended
- Submit immunization information

Adult Special *(At least 21 years of age and have not graduated from high school or have not earned a GED with a score of 450)*

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Schedule an appointment with the Assistant Director of Admissions to determine what courses are available

Audit *(Attend courses but will not receive a credit or a grade)*

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)

Transient *(Take courses for one semester then transfer back to another college)*

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Submit official* transcripts from the last institution attended
- *Submit other transcripts if needed for pre-requisites*
- Submit immunization information

Academically Talented/Gifted *(Freshman or sophomores in TN high schools who are documented as academically talented/gifted and college courses are part of IEP placement)*

- Complete Application for Admission (paper or online)
- Submit official* high school transcripts
- Submit signed letter of consent from parent/guardian and principal
- Submit copy of IEP

International
