



## Health Information Checklist for New Admissions

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Students entering any Allied Health Program at Columbia State must submit evidence of good health, a background and driving check, and a 10-panel drug screen including urine alcohol. Please return all Health information forms to Deb Heidlebaugh in WARF 130-A at least 30 days before the first day of classes.

Please use this form as a tool to stay on track with your healthcare information needed for clinicals. Do not return it with your paperwork.

- A. TB Skin Test  
(Must be within 3 months of starting Clinical then annually while in the Radiologic Technology Program) \_\_\_\_\_
- B. Chest X-ray (Only required if you have a positive TB Skin Test) \_\_\_\_\_
- C. Mumps (IGG) Titer \_\_\_\_\_
- D. Rubella (IGG) Titer \_\_\_\_\_
- E. Rubeola (IGG) Titer \_\_\_\_\_
- F. Varicella Zoster (IGG) Titer (or physician verified documentation of the disease) \_\_\_\_\_
- G. Tetanus/Diphtheria Booster (Must be within 10 years) \_\_\_\_\_
- H. Hepatitis B Series or signed declination form  
(Series of 3 immunizations over several months) \_\_\_\_\_
- I. Hepatitis B Titer (Surface Antigen)  
(Required 60 days after 3<sup>rd</sup> immunization and if you had the Hepatitis B series) \_\_\_\_\_
- J. Background Check including driving check  
(Do not order before July 12, 2010. The "driving check" must be submitted annually while in the Radiologic Technology Program) \_\_\_\_\_
- K. 10-panel Drug Screen including urine alcohol screen  
(Do not order before July 12, 2010 and must be submitted annually while in the Radiologic Technology Program ) \_\_\_\_\_
- L. BLS Card  
(American Heart Association "BLS for Healthcare Providers)  
(front and back copy) \_\_\_\_\_
- M. Proof of Health Insurance  
(Front & Back copy of insurance card submitted annually while in the Radiologic Technology Program) \_\_\_\_\_

**PLEASE NOTE:** If your titers do not show immunity to mumps, measles (Rubella & Rubeola), or Varicella Zoster (Chicken Pox), you will need to get the appropriate vaccine and have another titer drawn 60 days after to check for immunity. If you do not show immunity to Hepatitis B you must go through the series a 2<sup>nd</sup> time or have a booster then have another titer drawn 60 days after to check for immunity.
