PATHWAY for AAS ("PAAS") Exclusive Course Transfer Policies

Listed below are the details of the agreement finalized for the transfer policy for general education courses as well as the individual AAS courses approved for transfer to Lipscomb University based on the 2012-2013 catalog. Revisions will be needed for substantive changes in future catalog years.

Students completing the AAS in Business from Columbia State Community College will have their coursework approved for transfer on a course-by-course comparison as detailed below. Per Lipscomb University policy, a maximum of 63 hours may be transferred from a two-year institution.
