PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA**

The performance targets below were established by Columbia State with input from the program's Advisory Committee & stakeholders. These benchmarks meet/exceed accreditation requirements.

Five year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography Exam) pass rate greater than or equal to 85% at first attempt within six months of graduation.

Five year average job placement rate of greater than or equal to 90% within 12 months of graduation (Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences. The JRCERT has defined not actively seeking employment as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education

Five Year Average	97%	91/94 graduates seeking employment were employed within 12 months of graduation

Annual Program completion rate greater than or equal to 80% with a five year average greater than or equal to 80% (Number of students completing within 150% of published program length)

Year	Percent Completion	Number of Students
Class of 2015	84%	25 students enrolled, 3 withdrew, 3 unsuccessful, 1 returned to complete fall 2015, 1 returned to complete spring 2016, 21/25 = 84%
Class of 2016	84%	25 students enrolled, 2 withdrew, 4 unsuccessful, 2 returned to complete spring 2017, 21/25= 84%
Class of 2017	65%	26 students enrolled, 4 withdrew, 8 unsuccessful, 3 returned to complete spring 2018, 17/26=65%
Class of 2018	77%	26 students enrolled, 3 withdrew, 6 unsuccessful, 2 returned to complete spring 2019, 19/26=73%
Class of 2019	92%	25 students enrolled, 3 unsuccessful, 1 returned to complete spring 2020, 23/25
Five Year Average	80%	101 Total Graduates/127 Original Enrollees = 80%
