



President's Leadership Society Program

What is the President's Leadership Society?

The Leadership Society is a free leadership training program focused on helping students develop and apply their unique leadership skills. During the course of the program you will attend a retreat, enjoy exposure to the arts, participate in workshops and campus life, develop civic understanding and give back to the community through service.

What do I gain through participation?

Through participation in the leadership program you will:

- Explore and develop your unique strengths and talents
- Develop a personal leadership style and the skills necessary to be a successful leader
- Make a difference on campus and in the community
- Gather experiences that will enhance job applications, resumes and interviews
- Receive recognition at graduation as a Presidential Leader through the award of a special medallion

How do I apply?

To participate in the program you must:

- Be currently enrolled in at least one credit hour at Columbia State
- Be in good standing with the college (minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA for continuing students)
- Complete a leadership program application
- Have completed not more than 18 credit hours

How do I complete the program?

- Attend a program orientation
- Complete a total of 12 approved activities with no more than 5 activities to be completed per semester
- Document program attendance through a passport portfolio
- Meet with the program coordinator to review the passport at least once each semester
- Maintain continuous enrollment at the college and in the leadership program to culmination at graduation
- Complete academic course requirements for the awarding of a degree or certificate
- Participate in a graduation ceremony

How much of a time commitment is the program?

One of the great things about the program is that you complete it at your own pace. Most workshops last about one hour. Your involvement in the program is spread over the time you are enrolled as a student until graduation.

How is the program designed?

Each time a student attends an approved activity and returns the passport form to the program coordinator at the end of the semester, they will be issued one stamp per activity completed in a specified category (up to 5 stamps per semester). In order to receive stamp, all activities must be a university sponsored event or approved by the program coordinator. The intent of the program is to provide the maximum flexibility necessary to enable students to participate in this valuable leadership opportunity while pursuing their academic studies, working and fulfilling other obligations.

A total of 12 stamps are required for completion of the leadership program with 9 of those required from the areas as set forth below and the remaining 3 to be in the area of the student's choice.

Self-Management & Goal Setting (2 stamps)

- 1. Etiquette
- 2. Health & Wellness
- 3. Personal Finance
- 4. Career Planning
- 5. Job Shadowing/Internships
- 6. Campus Visits (for students transferring to 4yr. college)
- 7. Personality & Learning Style Inventory

Culture (4 stamps with no more than 2 stamps in any one subset)

- 1. Theatrical Performances
- 2. Music Appreciation
- 3. Art Appreciation
- 4. Lecture Series
- 5. Diversity Programming

Civic Understanding (1 stamp)

- 1. County Commission
- 2. City Council
- 3. School Board
- 4. Tennessee Intercollegiate State Legislature activities
- 5. Any other approved civic function

Campus Life (1 stamp)

- 1. Student Athlete
- 2. SGA Member
- 3. Phi Theta Kappa Member
- 4. Peer Counseling
- 5. Campus Volunteer
- Membership in any campus sanctioned club, group or activity not otherwise listed (pre-approved)
- 7. Contributor to Perceptions
- 8. CSCC Athletic Event attendance

Community Service (1 stamp)

Any pre-approved service project or volunteer involvement
